Your role will include:

- Conduct research around different restoration projects (reforestation, forest conservation, agricultural land management, grassland management...).
- Research for developing carbon profiles.
- Support in the VCS (Verified Carbon Standard) and CCB (Climate, Community & Biodiversity) certification;
- Support in the development of technical documentation such as monitoring plans, sampling designs for field data collection, interpretation of satellite imagery, etc;
- Academic writing and assisting with Project Documentation;
- Support restoration projects in the broadest sense.

Profile and skills:

To be eligible for the position, you are/have:

- Completed (or be in the last year) of an Environmental-related degree;
- Have a strong knowledge of forestry, ecology, sustainability, or similar fields;
- Being able to document methodological processes and write high-quality reports in an academic style;
- Experience with remote sensing tools (e.g. QGIS, LiDAR, SAR);
- Being able to work both in team and independently;
- Fluency in written and spoken English, Portuguese is a plus;

- Strong interest in environment-related areas, especially in the restoration and conservation fields;
- Preferably based in the Netherlands, we love to work together at the office, as it facilitates supervision and enables short communication and feedback loops.
