The team also initiates and executes the first development phase of new commercial SAF production facilities. If there proves to be an opportunity to develop a SAF production facility, the Capacity Development team takes over. A dedicated project team performs in-depth analyses, engages partners and other stakeholders and prepares the project for final engineering and construction.

As an intern you will contribute to one or two projects in these focus areas by working closely with the team. Based on your interests and background, we will jointly determine the focus of your internship, including in which team you will perform your internship. Typical activities include:

- · Conducting technical, financial or sustainability assessments on future SAF production facilities
- Developing knowledge on promising SAF feedstocks and/or technologies
- Performing analyses to understand the potential of a certain region for SAF production
- Supporting on business development for new opportunities
- Writing reports and composing presentations
